Why do you need website?


- Source of truth for your business





Personas


- Map out a typical user and what they would want from your business.




Starting with a basic template

Promote the site

- Search Engine Optimization: tools available to optimize
- Social media
- Paid advertising
- Word of mouth
- Traditional advertising

Stats

- Analyze: Keep track of you visitor statistics
- Use tools to review user sessions
- Setup user 'funnels' to track how users use your website
- <u>ahrefs.com</u> and PostHog are tools to analyze your website position and user behavior

Maintain your site

- Add and update content as needed
- Make sure content is up to date for critical things like hours of operation, phone numbers, staff listings etc.
- Revisit your site content, make sure it is still relevant for your business.
- Add a blog to help build keywords and SEO
